Hours

8am to 1pm Monday through Friday with 2 to 3 hours of additional prep time per week. In addition, weekly staff meetings, quarterly all staff meetings, and additional school functions are also mandatory.

Qualifications

We're open to a variety of professional backgrounds.

Education: At least high school diploma or equivalent

Experience: Must have a minimum of two years prior experience with children, preferably in an early learning setting.

Faith: As a community with a shared statement of faith, an active, intentional, and embodied Christian faith is essential.

Licensure/Certification:

Must have the following, or be willing to complete upon hire:

- Washington State required 30 hours basic training or show proof of waiver
- Adult/infant/child CPR and first aid
- HIV and bloodborne pathogen training
- Proof of negative TB skin test
- Portable background check through Merit

- Must be 18 years of age or older
- Other licensing related requirements may apply
