- Possess (or work towards) a valid Washington State teaching certificate with endorsement in ELA for middle school and/or high school
- Knowledge of and/or experience with instruction of youth using sound research-based instruction, best practices, and pedagogy.
- Experience in teaching all levels of secondary Language Arts/English, Literature, Writing and Grammar, Speaking, and Listening
- Knowledge of and application of educational technology
